NEW Kids Ride Free on NY Waterway Ferries Effective Friday, November 24:

- Kids under 12 can ride on NY Waterway's ferries for free on all routes between New Jersey & Manhattan beginning Friday, Nov 24th 2023 through Monday, January 1st 2024. The ticketing policy for the free service is: two children are permitted to ride free per each paying adult rider.
